The main task of the thesis was developing a Czech Bench, a collection of Czech data sets and scripts to evaluate Large Language Models (LLM) in Czech. The thesis is focusing on testing foundational and instruction-aligned LLMs in several categories, question-answering systems, generating text, etc. It also tries to evaluate coherence and factuality of the generated text. The work was based on similar existing LLM tests for English. Provide estimation of the accuray of exidsting models in Czech.

The student has delivered a comprehensive study of the task at hand. He reviewed a significant amount of literature and summarized it in the initial sections of the thesis. He then learned evaluation of several English LLM platforms and selected the most promising ones and translated the scripts to Czech. This included not only the translation but also creation and modification of testing scripts to adjust for Czech. He also tested to trained several Czech LLMs. All training and experiments are documented in detail in the results section.

### Activity and independence when creating final thesis
